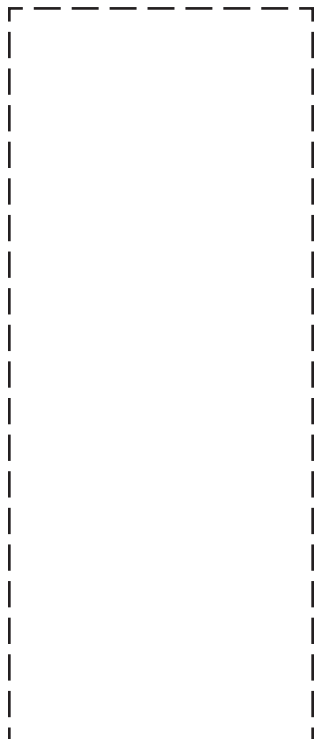

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted until Thursday, February 28, 2019, at 6:00 p.m., after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

ENTRY FEE: TD - \$60.00, TDX - \$125.00. A \$.50 recording fee plus \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per Chapter 11, Section 2 of the AKC Rules. Make checks payable to **PAFTA**.

MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO: Karey Krauter, Test Secretary, 374 Stanford Avenue, Palo Alto, CA 94306.

ELIGIBILITY: TD entries limited to 3 dogs with appropriate Certification or that have previously passed an AKC Tracking Test. TDX entry is limited to 3 dogs that have previously passed an AKC Tracking Test. Test Secretary will give priority to dogs who do not already hold the title for the test level entered. Entries are limited to AKC recognized pure breed dogs.

EXCHANGE of TRACKS: If the limit for entries is not reached in either the TD or TDX test and the other is exceeded, the number of tracks offered may be exchanged on the basis of two (2) TD tracks for one (1) TDX track.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and provided that all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations are complied with.

DRAWING: A random drawing of entries received by the closing date and time will be held on Thursday, February 28, 2019, at 6:15 p.m. at Starbucks, 2000 El Camino Real, Palo Alto CA 94306, phone 650-320-8125.

ALTERNATE LIST: An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

CERTIFICATION: With each entry of a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original statement, dated within one year, signed by a person who has been approved by the AKC to judge a Tracking Test, certifying that the dog is considered by him or her to be ready for such a test.

NOTIFICATION: The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

PAFTA REFUND POLICY: The entry fee shall be refunded within seven (7) days after the test in the following cases: 1) The entrant notifies the Test Secretary prior to the Test that they are withdrawing from the test, and an alternate runs the track, or 2) For an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER: All dogs and handlers must be at the test area by the designated times shown below on Sunday, March 10, 2019, at which time there will be a draw to determine the running order. Entrants not present at the time of their draw will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place. TD – 8:00 a.m., TDX – 10:00 a.m..

JUDGING: Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

AWARDS: An award will be offered for each dog passing the test.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

DIRECTIONS: 101 North or South - exit at Cochrane Road. Go East on Cochrane to Malaguerra Avenue (about 1 mile). Left onto Malaguerra Avenue and follow for 0.4 mile. The road bears to the left into the Park parking lot. Parking is free and there is a covered area and rest rooms by the ranger station.

PRACTICING: Practicing on the test sites is not allowed except by ID-carrying members of clubs which have obtained a use permit. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leash at **ALL** times. Your cooperation in adhering to the regulations will be greatly appreciated. Handlers are expected to clean up after their dogs immediately.

NOTE: You are advised to bring tick spray for your dog and yourself as ticks are present in the area.
