CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted until Thursday, October 29, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

ENTRY FEE: \$125.00. A \$.50 recording fee plus \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are included in each entry and will be forwarded to the AKC per Chapter 11, Section 2 of the AKC Rules. Make checks payable to **PAFTA**.

MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO: Cindy Ievers, Test Secretary, 50 Hartford Ave., San Carlos, CA 94070.

ELIGIBILITY: This test is for dogs that have earned the TD, TDX, or TDU title. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the VST title. However, the test secretary shall give priority to entries for dogs that do not hold the VST title. Entries are limited to 4 dogs. Entries are limited to AKC recognized pure breed dogs.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and provided that all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations are complied with.

DRAWING: A random drawing of entries received by the closing date and time will be held on October 29, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., at Menchie's Frozen Yogurt, 1200 El Camino Real A3, Belmont, CA 94002, phone 650-802-8373.

ALTERNATES: An alternate list shall be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

NOTIFICATION: The results of the draw will be sent as soon as possible following the draw. Should such notification not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

REFUND POLICY: Alternates who opt to decline to be placed on the alternate list shall have their entry fees returned. Entrants and alternates who do not run in this test, but are replaced by an alternate who runs in the test, shall have their full entry fee returned.

TEST HOURS: All dogs and handlers must be at **EVERGREEN VALLEY COLLEGE** by 9:00 a.m. Sunday, November 8, 2020, at which time there will be a drawing to determine running order. Entrants not present at the time of the drawing will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place.

JUDGING: Judging will begin as soon as the tracks have aged sufficiently.

AWARDS: A green rosette and award will be offered for each dog passing the test.

The **HEALTH AND SAFETY** of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in California.

DIRECTIONS TO EVERGREEN VALLEY COLLEGE: Parking free on Sunday. From the North or South: Take US-101. Take the Yerba Buena Rd exit (exit 381). Turn left onto Yerba Buena Rd. Continue east on Yerba Buena Rd for about 3 miles. Go past San Felipe Rd about .3 mile and turn left into Evergreen Valley College Parking Lot #9 - first turn out.

DIRECTIONS TO WEST VALLEY COLLEGE: Parking \$3.00/day, 7 days/wk From the North: Take Hwy 280 to Hwy 85 South. Take the Saratoga Ave exit; turn right onto Saratoga Ave, then turn left onto Fruitvale Ave. Continue to Parking Lot #6, opposite Douglass Lane, by the tennis courts.
From the South: Take Hwy 101 North to Hwy 85 North. Take the Saratoga Ave exit; turn left onto Saratoga Ave, then turn left onto Fruitvale Ave. Continue to Parking Lot #6, opposite Douglass Lane, by the tennis courts.

PRACTICING: Practicing on the test sites is allowed up to 3 days prior to test. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leash at **ALL** times. Your cooperation in adhering to the schools' regulations and cleaning up after your dogs is mandatory.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (we) agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between the AKC and the event-giving club (unless otherwise stated in its premium list) and myself (ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association. However, prior to arbitration, all applicable AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and procedures must first be followed as set forth in the AKC Charter and Bylaws, Rules, Regulations, Published Policies, and Guidelines.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collies (rough, smooth).
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. COVID-19 Best Practices: Our goal is to keep everyone as safe as we can. If any exhibitor is sick, know they have been exposed to COVID-19 or uncomfortable with the precautions PAFTA is taking, **do not enter**, and stay home. Our mental and physical well-being is most important at all times. Remember when entering a tracking test, it is done at your own risk. If you have not read the Agreement in your trial entry, you should do so now and be aware of what you are signing.

We will be following the rules and guidelines set forward by our state, county, and local agencies along with CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers, and exhibitors as safe as possible.

If you have traveled out of the state in the last 14 days, consider staying home. If you have a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or problems breathing, fever/chills, muscle pain or a loss of taste or smell, **STAY HOME!** If you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms listed above, **STAY HOME.**

- ❖ Wear facial masks when in close proximity to others and /or when required by the club (**bring your own mask**). Masks will be worn over the nose and mouth at all times. Facial netting and masks with vents or valves are **NOT** acceptable facial covering or masks.
- ❖ Wash hands as frequently as possible. **Bring your own hand sanitizer.**
- ❖ Leave at least a vehicle or two spaces between your vehicles. There is plenty of parking.
- ❖ Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines.
- ❖ Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- ❖ Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- ❖ Avoid touching dogs that are not yours, as the owner may have kissed their dog.
- ❖ Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.
- ❖ The gallery should practice social distancing guidelines.

Tracklayers WILL be handling/scenting the articles. If you are uncomfortable handling the articles, please wear disposable/washable gloves (bring your own gloves).

IMPORTANT 30 Day Rules

1. No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the event.

2. People cannot act as tracklayers for dogs if, within the past 30 days, they have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler. The judges will determine the order in which the tracks are run and the number of each track. The judges may modify the draw to meet the requirements of the tracklayer.
